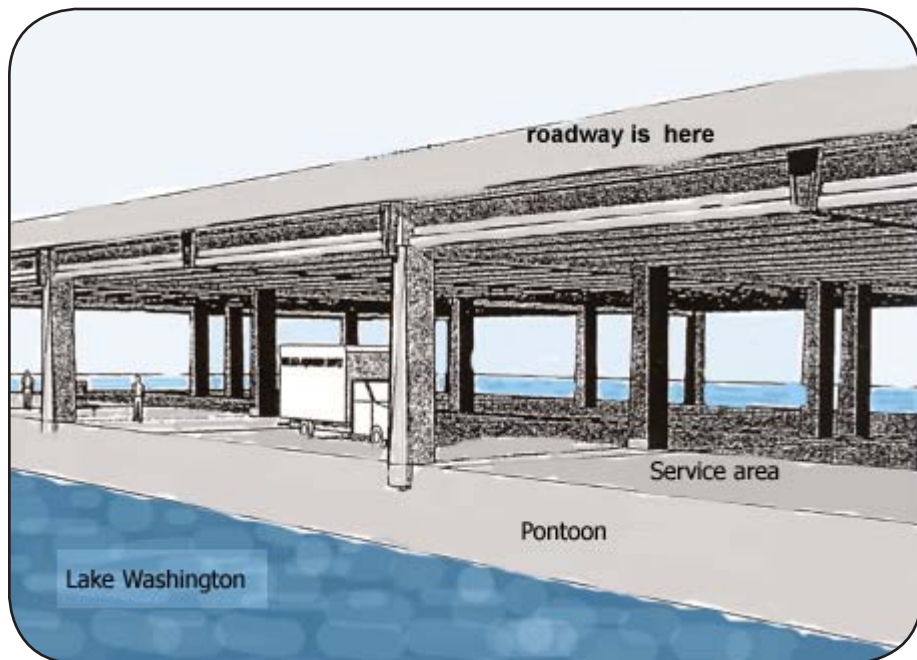

1) Join with the Madison Park Community Council and the Coalition for a Sustainable 520 to create a new consensus. Call these decision-makers and let them know that you:

Oppose Option A+

Oppose the proposed high bridge across the lake

Dedicate new capacity to transit

Reduce the footprint on the west side and produce a context-sensitive design

Respect Arboretum and the corridor communities.

2) **We don't want to have any construction started until a design for all of 520 is agreed.** If the east side and/or the pontoon bridge is built, there will be more pressure for a cheap and harmful 1950's style highway rammed through the city.
